Frequently Asked Questions

Is this the same as the full TAE40122 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment?

No. TAESS00024 is a targeted skill set designed specifically for teachers delivering VET to school students. It provides credit towards TAE40122, but it is not the full qualification.

Will this skill set allow me to deliver VET to secondary school students?

This skill set is designed for qualified teachers who are permitted to deliver VETDSS programs under their state or system requirements. Individual school or system policies will determine how the units are used for registration or allocation to VET programs.

What are the entry requirements?

Participants are normally existing secondary school teachers who hold a Bachelor of Education or higher, or qualified teachers able to register for delivery in secondary schools in Australia.

How much time will I need to commit?

You should allow for scheduled workshop time plus additional time for assessment tasks, research and application in your school context. The total learning time is approximately 85 hours.

How is the course delivered?

Delivery is primarily face-to-face, supported by project work, assessment tasks and guided self-directed learning. Digital tools are used to support resource design, assessment and validation.

We can deliver self-paced online with trainer support or in our virtual classroom the same as a class.. You need to be motivated to complete TAE courses self-paced. Resources and a trainer are available to assist you.

Is recognition of prior learning (RPL) available?

Yes. If you already have relevant VET or assessment experience, you may be able to have some skills recognised through RPL. SSI will provide guidance on evidence requirements.

Can this program be customised to our school or system needs?

Yes. SSI can contextualise examples, projects and assessment activities to align with your school's VET offerings, policies and learner cohort.
